Serving the community.....five years of achievement

ON THE 19th of May 2019, we celebrate five years since community station 2YOUFM switched to 88.9fm.

Since 2014, we have seen an enormous turnaround of the station following a business model that was implemented to allow the station to grow and serve the region's community.

The early days for a not-for-profit organisation held many essential challenges in funding and finding the right people, formats, equipment upgrades and services to be provided to the community.

There were some early opposition to the changes but, gradually, this dropped away as the community recognised our ultimate goal - to embrace the community with a radio station to serve them.

Some five years on, I'm humbled by how far we have come and now recognised by our own industry to be one of the leading Community Radio Stations in Australia and the largest in regional Australia.

More than that, it has been the passion from the Board members to the presenters and staff, that has helped build the station through their contribution and various talents. Some have moved on and some have been with the station from the beginning.



The talented on air presenters are recognised daily by listeners but there is a professional team behind them that contribute to make the station work. Sales, news, administration, production, accounts, scheduling, and technical.

There have been many small and large achievements reached in the last five years, including \$335,000 reinvested to upgrade the studio operations and transmission facilities, a regional

news service, and the many other program services that communicate with the community just to name a few.



The RUAWARE WE CARE CONCERT for drought relief for farmers in association with Tamworth Regional Council, Salvation Army, along with many other organisations that raised \$1.6

million dollars in cash and kind that we saw go directly to farming families across the region, is an example of what a community station can achieve.



With changes such as in technology and social media, the station has the opportunity to serve the community even more in coming years as it has done in the last five years.


